Cost Vs. Benefit

State-specific regulatory impact

Ask facility what wastes they can recycle

Do not mix recyclable materials together without first discussing with the disposal/processing/recycling facility

- Scrap Metals (Steel, Copper, etc)
- Valuable Metals (That would otherwise be hazardous)
 - Magnesium, Aluminum, Zinc, Lead
- Universal Wastes
 - Fluorescent Light Tubes
 - Batteries
 - High Metals Content (Nickel, Lithium, Lead)
- Electronic Scrap
- Oil and Antifreeze (most facilities want these separate)
- Oil Filters
- Latex Paints

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
