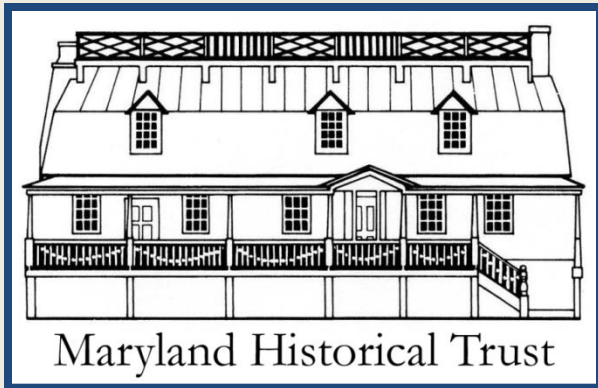
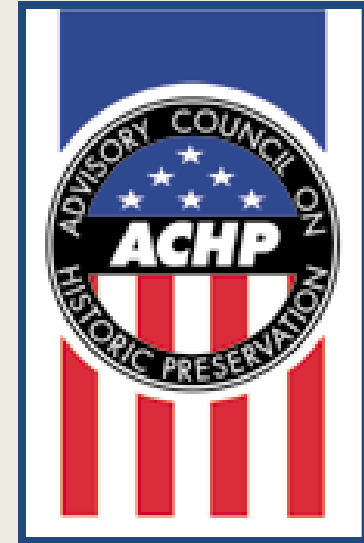
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# *SHPO - Legislative Mandates*

## State Law:

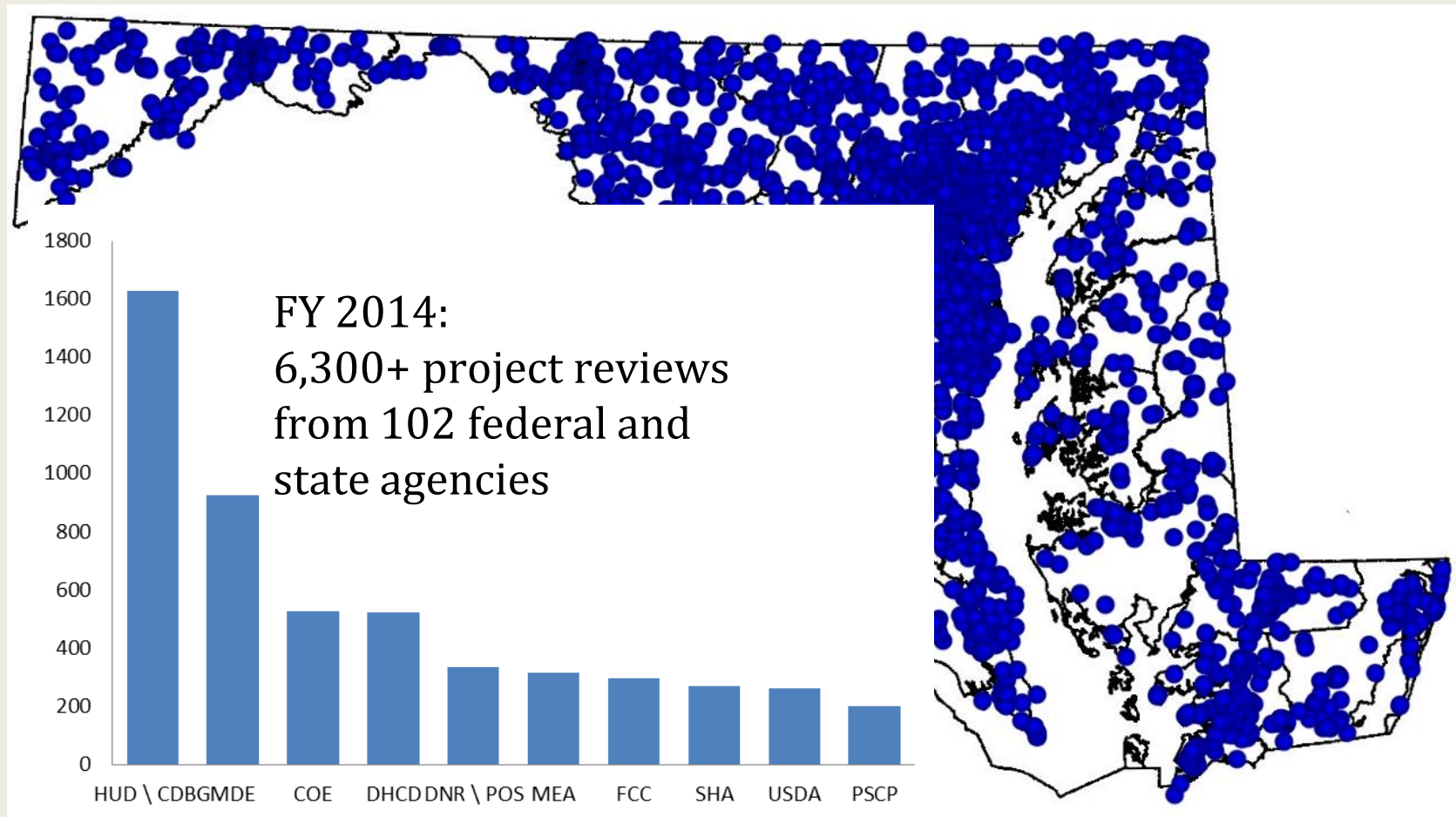

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# *Section 106 - Getting Started*

## What is an Undertaking?

A project, activity, or program that uses state or federal funds or that requires a state or federal permit or license

## Project Types Subject to Review

- Construction
- Demolition
- Rehabilitation of Existing Facilities
- Infrastructure Improvements (roads, utilities, etc.)
- Ancillary Activities
- Wetland Mitigation
- Access Roads, Staging Areas
- Dredging

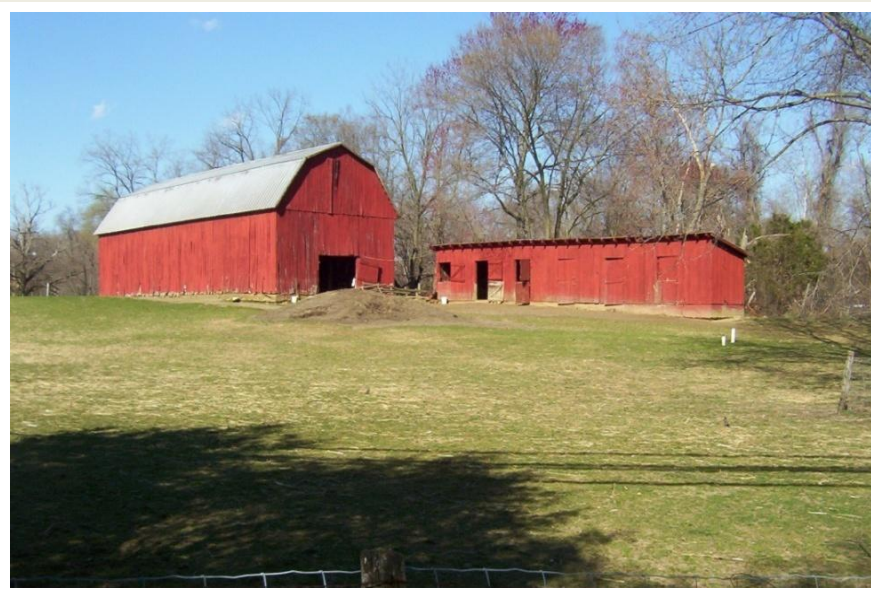
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# *Identifying Historic Properties*

significant in our past



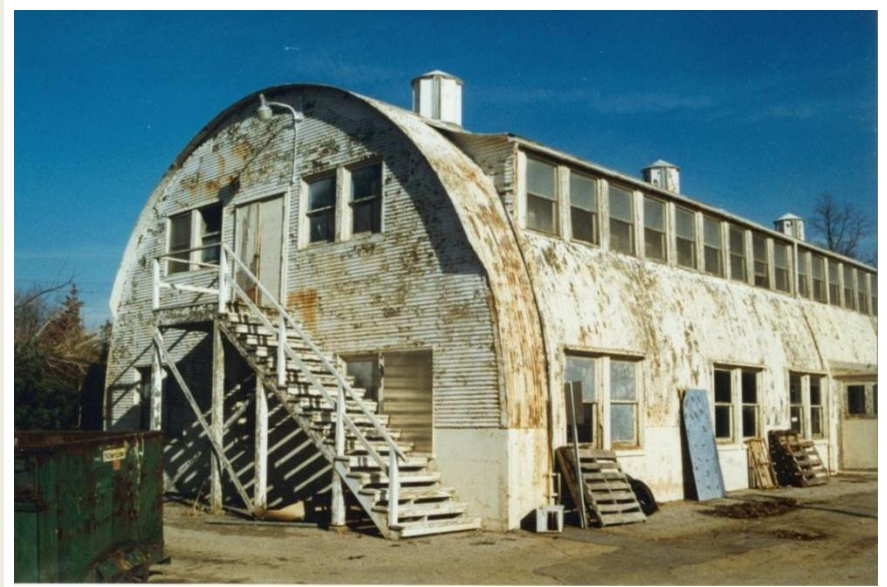
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# *Identifying Historic Properties*

Properties typical of a type, period, or method of construction

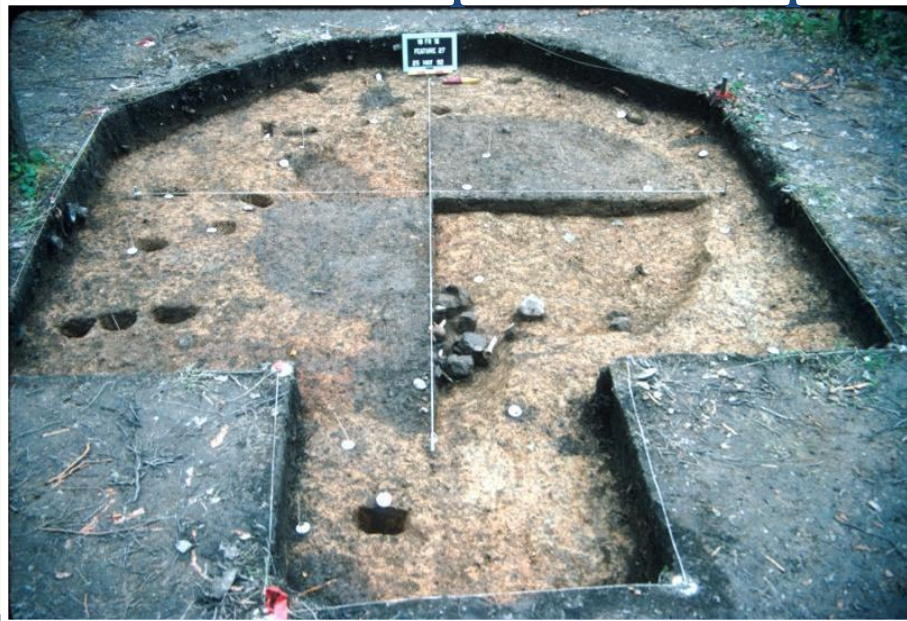

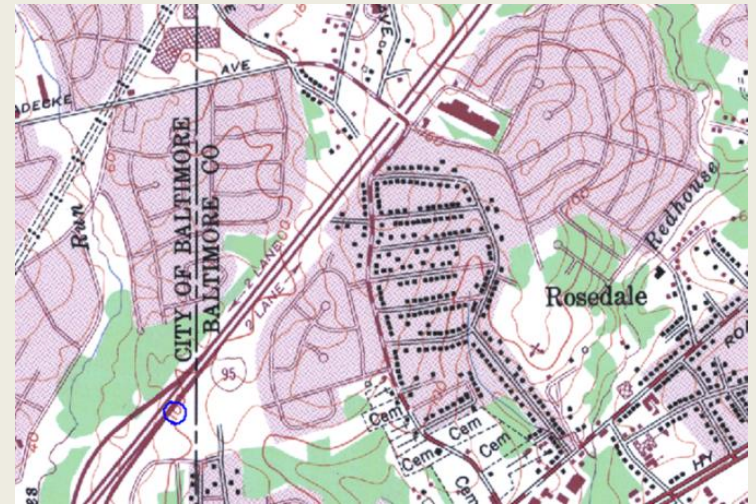

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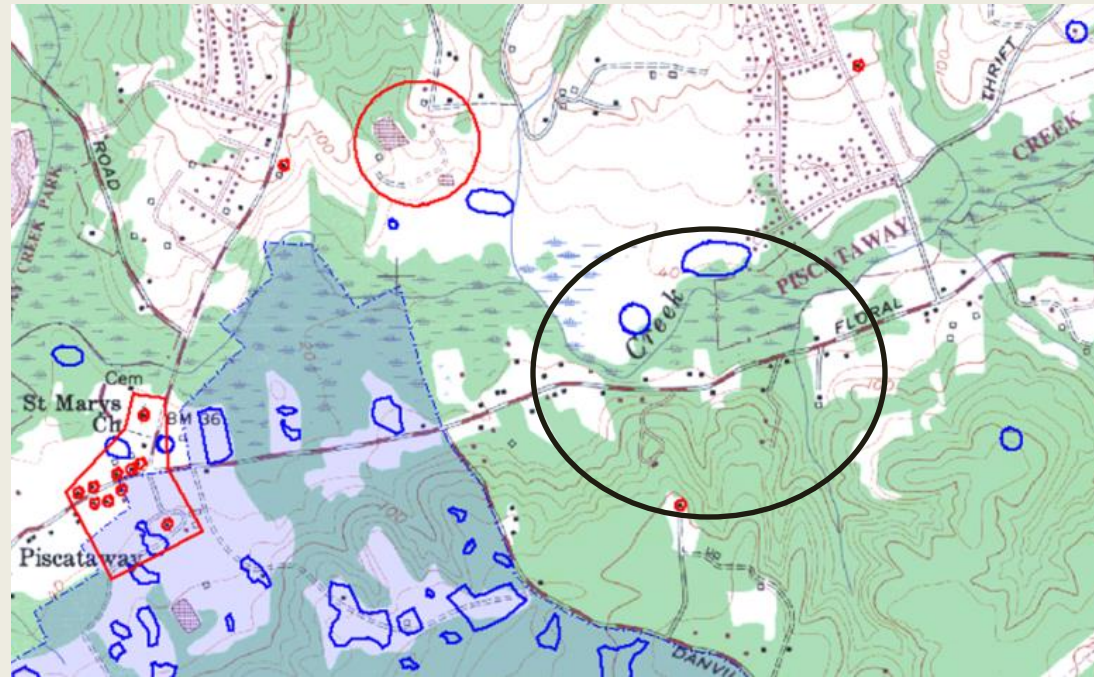

- Continue consultation
- Notify the ACHP
- Involve consulting parties
- Provide documentation to all consulting parties
- Involve the public
- Develop MOA
- Proceed with project



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# *Resolving Adverse Effects*

## Involve Consulting Parties



- MHT / MD SHPO
- Other federal/state agencies
- Local governments
- Indian tribes / MCIA
- Applicants for federal/state assistance, permits, licenses
- Owners of affected properties
- Preservation advocacy groups
- Certified Heritage Areas
- Other organizations
- The public



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# *Section 106 - Role of the MHT/ MD SHPO*

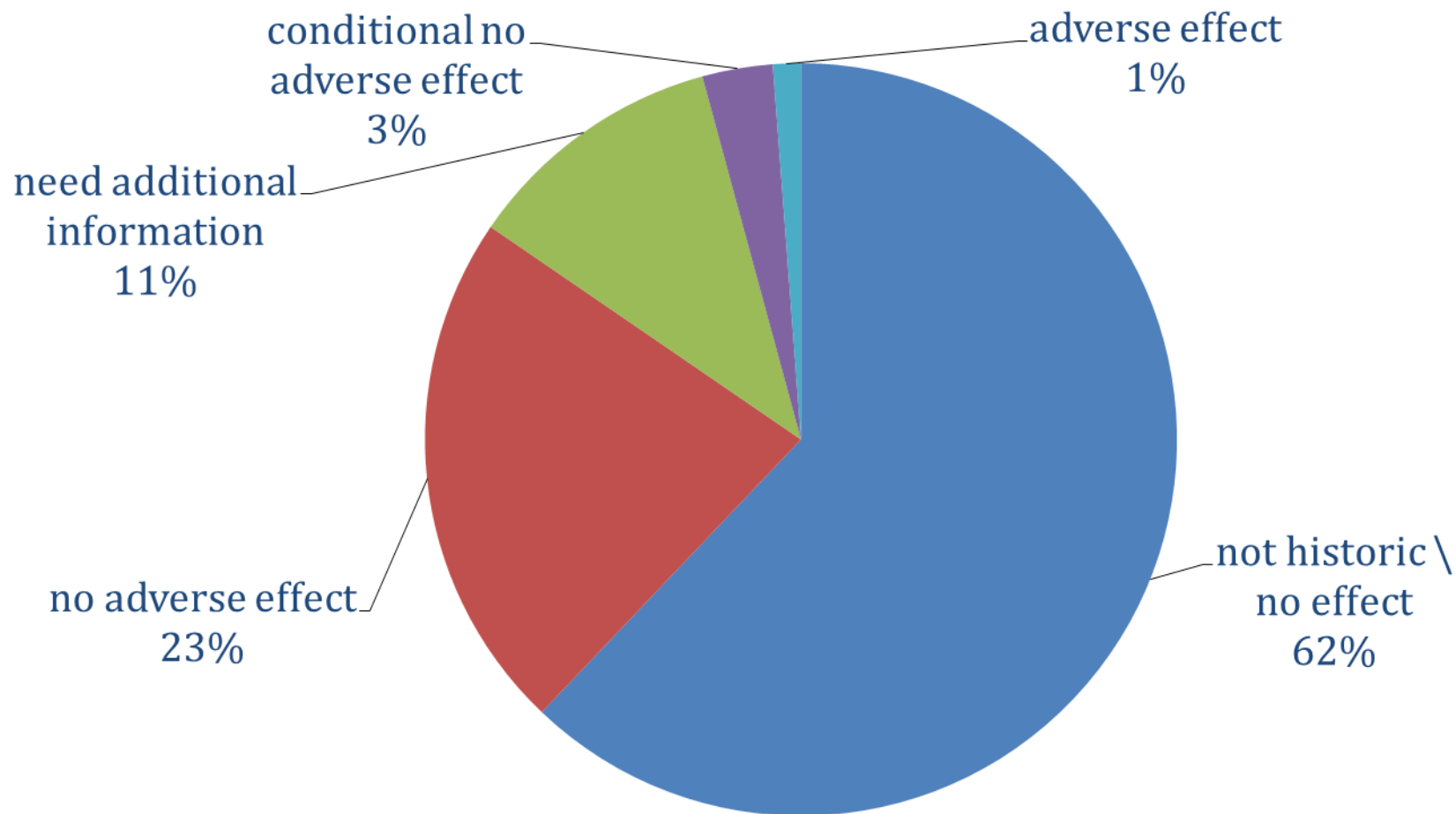
- Key participant in consultation
- Ensure compliance with historic preservation legislation
- Assist in identifying historic properties potentially affected by an undertaking
- Assess the undertaking's effects on the properties
- Seek ways to avoid, minimize or mitigate any adverse effects
- SHPO is both a resource agency and a facilitator

- Consult early & often
- Involve all parties
- Consider alternatives
- Public participation informs planning
- Keep an open mind
- Make a good faith effort



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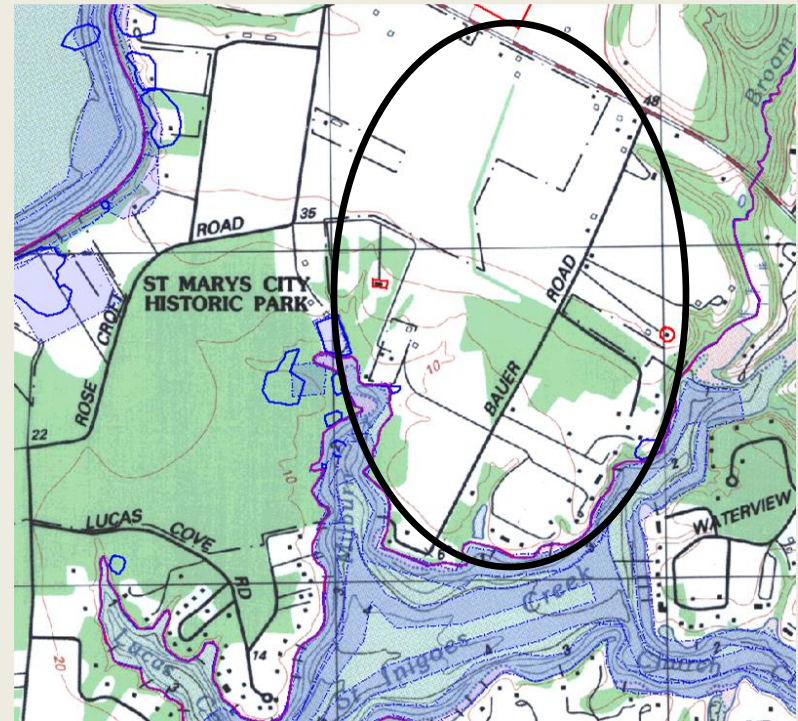
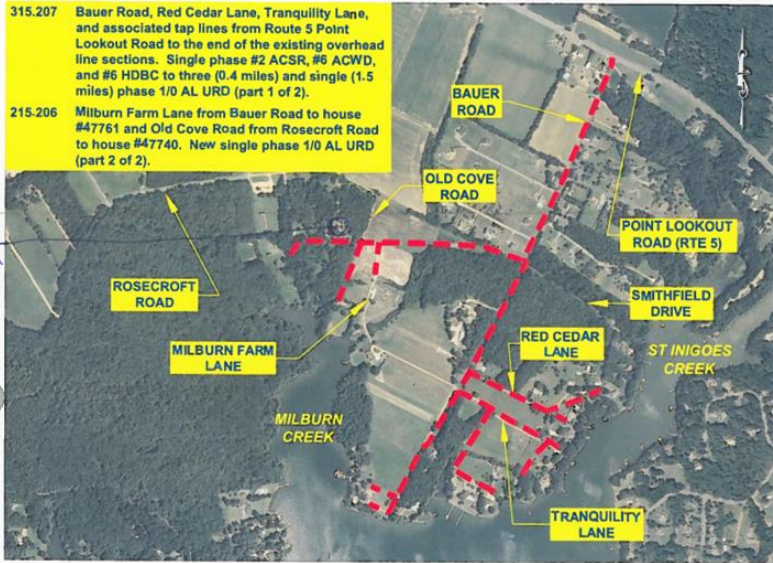


# Section 106: Tips for Success

Example of successful early coordination – Multi-Year Work Plan:  
MHT reviewed 127 proposed undertakings – only 4 had the potential to impact significant historic properties and required further coordination.

## BAUER ROAD, RED CEDAR LANE, TRANQUILITY LANE, MILBURN FARM LANE AND OLD COVE ROAD OFF ROSECROFT ROAD

- 315.207 Bauer Road, Red Cedar Lane, Tranquility Lane, and associated tap lines from Route 5 Point Lookout Road to the end of the existing overhead line sections. Single phase #2 ACSR, #6 ACWD, and #6 HDGC to three (0.4 miles) and single (1.5 miles) phase 1/0 AL URD (part 1 of 2).
- 215.206 Milburn Farm Lane from Bauer Road to house #47761 and Old Cove Road from Rosecroft Road to house #47740. New single phase 1/0 AL URD (part 2 of 2).
